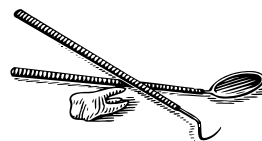

Certified Nursing Assistant Training Courses

This 77-hour Certified Nursing Assistant course is recommended if you are interested in a nursing career or if you are seeking employment as a Certified Nursing Assistant.

This Minnesota Department of Health approved course will focus on basic nursing skills and will be presented through the use of lecture, textbook, handout materials and demonstrations. Skills are demonstrated and practiced in a supervised laboratory setting and clinical environment.

All students must have a background study done at the beginning of the course as a state requirement for clinical placement in Minnesota.

Classes start October 6, October 20 & December 15, 2009 at the Higher Education Center located at 1110 14th Street South, Moorhead, MN, Room 143. Cost: \$485 (includes materials, mantoux TB skin test and the background study fee). **Call for brochures or visit our website at www.cts.minnesota.edu.**

Completion of this course enables you to take the Nurse Aide Competency Evaluation. The competency evaluation is a separate fee of \$150.

After successfully completing the competency evaluation, you will be placed on the Minnesota Nursing Assistant Registry. This registration can be easily transferred to North Dakota and most other states.

Attendance is mandatory to successfully complete this course.
