Prepare medications according to facility policy. Perform the correct setup of supplies. Perform surgical reconciliation counts according to hospital and facility policy. Manipulate surgical instrumentation to anticipate surgical team needs. Verify and identify all specimens obtained. Perform sterilization procedures. Clean and restock equipment and supplies as needed. Apply principles of robotics. Perform patient skin preparation under the direction of the circulator. Perform the correct setup of instruments and equipment. Perform the correct setup of surgical fields.
