Compare different Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registered disinfectants, their mix ratios and immersion time.</li> <li>4. Identify the different types of fire extinguishers and how to effectively use them.</li> <li>5. Summarize Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Center for Disease Control (CDC) regulations in regard to their importance to the salon.</li> <li>6. Define Safety Data Sheets (SDS) and why they are required in the salon.</li> <li>7. Identify Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and when it is used.</li> <li>8.
