Description:	In this course, students learn the importance of proper shampooing techniques, product selection and client interaction to enhance the overall salon experience.

Observe proper steps in performing shampooing services. Identify the four types of tools required to perform shampooing services and the proper decontamination practices required to remain compliant with the Minnesota Board of Cosmetology. Demonstrate the basic massage movements performed during shampooing services. Discuss various types of scalp care services and their benefits. Analyze the texture, density, curl pattern, elasticity and porosity of natural hair. Identify scalp and hair conditions and contraindications.
