Examine non-surgical periodontal debridement procedures.5. Describe power instrumentation, techniques, indications and contraindications.6. Describe dental implant indications, processes and dental hygiene maintenance.7. Describe indications and contraindications for locally administered antibiotics or chemical agents.
