

ELL0060 - English Language Learner Reading

Description:	This reading course is for non-native learners of English. Students will learn the skills and vocabulary necessary to read college-level materials with emphasis given to effective note taking and summarizing. Students will engage in frequent large and small group discussions of reading material and be exposed to a variety of reading strategies.

Understand a number of reading methods. Participate in group discussions and understand effective group work especially acknowledging the opinions of others and identifying threads of conversation. Express oral opinions to represent the perspective of the individual and others. Become aware of issues of academic integrity when summarizing or paraphrasing others' writings.
