

## HPER1100 - Varsity Clay Target Competition

Description:	This course provides students with the opportunity to develop skills in gun and range safety while participating in organized clay target sports. Emphasis is placed on the hands-on learning of safe shotgun handling, mental focus, and the technical skills required to break clay targets in disciplines such as trap, skeet or sporting clays.
