Describe the effect of the Minnesota miscellaneous statutes on the plumbing industry in Minnesota. Describe the tier of authority of plumbing officials and licensed plumbers in both Minnesota and North Dakota. Describe the types of licenses in the plumbing field and the requirements for obtaining them in Minnesota and North Dakota. Compare and contrast the codes of Minnesota and North Dakota.
