Description:	Meets MnTC Goal Area 6. Students will explore the fundamental design principles, materials and application techniques of stage make-up. Beginning with make-up fundamentals, students will progress to more advanced projects including aging, special effects, Kabuki, animal and fantasy. Student work will culminate with a final project and a final portfolio.
