Description:	This course will provide students with an introduction to the planning and management of sports facilities. Students will examine legal aspects of hosting sporting events. Topics will include security, liability, safety, maintenance, signage and operating facilities.

Discuss the importance of public sports facilities including schools, arenas and community centers in relation to community health and wellness.
