

ENGL Guided Self-Placement

Students without a high school GPA, whose high school GPA 10+ years, English Language Learners (ELL), or international students will meet with an academic advisor prior to registering for ENGL course(s).

** All students please answer the following questions:

- 1. What language did you learn to speak first?
- 2. Which language do you speak most often at home?
- 3. How many years of education (elementary through high school) were in the United States?

I should enroll in **ENGL 1101 College Writing** if most of the following statements describe me.

- I comfortably read and understand high school textbooks and other reading assigned by my high school teachers, as well as other popular publications.
- I have written high school papers of 4 or more pages and earned grades of C+ or higher.
- I can support and organize my ideas in writing.
- I have been able to revise rough drafts of essays as necessary to meet assignment expectations.

I should enroll in **ENGL 0097 English Strategies/ENGL 0098^ Accelerated English** if most of the following statements describe me.

- I have written high school papers of 2-3 pages and earned passing grades.
- I can read and understood high school textbooks, assigned readings or popular publications, even if I read slowly.
- I am familiar with supporting and organizing my ideas in writing, but want more practice using these skills.
- Sometimes I needed extra help in high school to complete reading and writing assignments, but for the most part I was able to work on my own.
- I would like a basic review and some extra support with reading skills, essay writing, and computer skills for college classes.

I should enroll in **ENGL 0091 English Foundations** if most of the following statements describe me.

- I have struggled to write high school papers of 2-3 pages.
- It's difficult for me to read high school textbooks or other assigned readings as well as popular publications.
- I often struggle to write sentences and paragraphs.
- I received additional support for reading and writing in high school (Examples: support classes, oneon-one instruction, extra time on assignments, shortened assignments, etc.)
- I would like in-depth instruction on reading skills, essay writing, and computer skills for college classes, including working with a tutor during class.



I should work with **Adult Basic Education (ABE)** if the following statements describe me.

- I'm not sure if college is a good fit for me, but I want to explore the possibilities.
- School at many levels has been a struggle for me, especially reading and writing.
- I would like more reading, writing, and computer skill instruction before entering college courses.
