Since 2017, the Minnesota Board of Cosmetology has required that each licensee must complete two courses totaling 8 hours of continuing education to renew or reactivate an operator or salon manager license.

M State offers the Core course and Professional Practice courses to satisfy the 8-hour requirement. Continuing education classes are offered online and on campus.

4-hour Core course

Three credits must pertain to health, safety and sanitation, and one hour must pertain to laws and rules. Online: \$55
