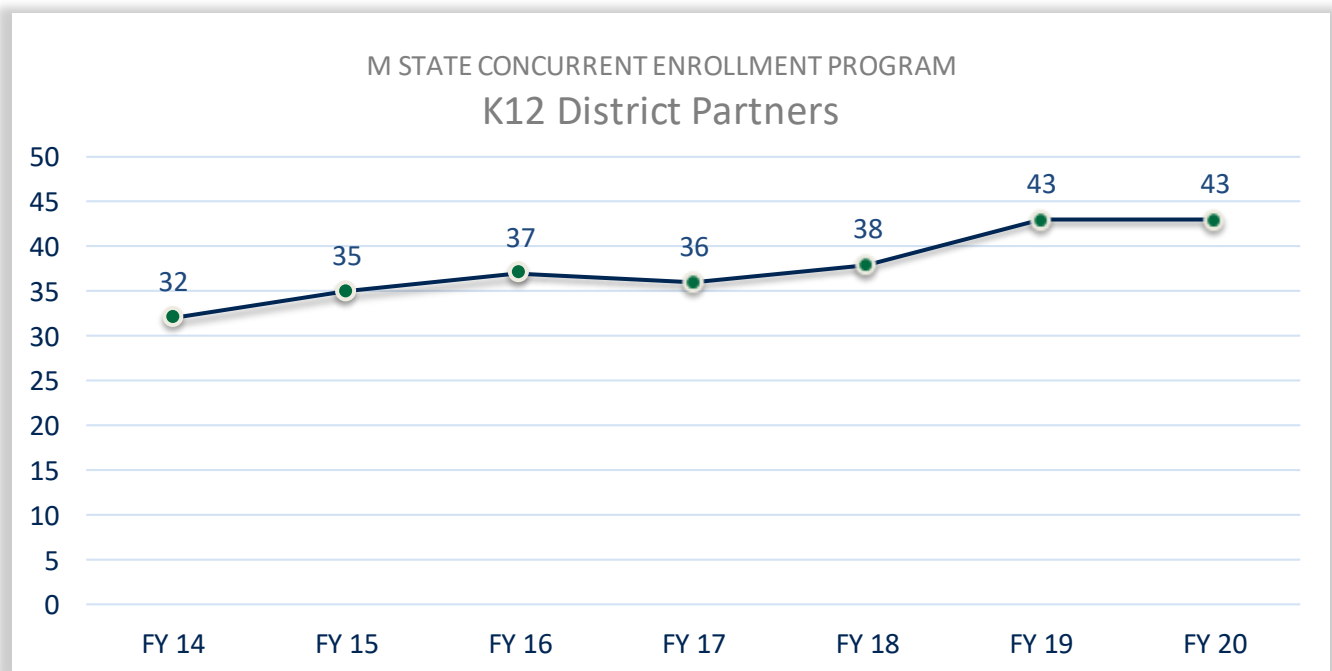

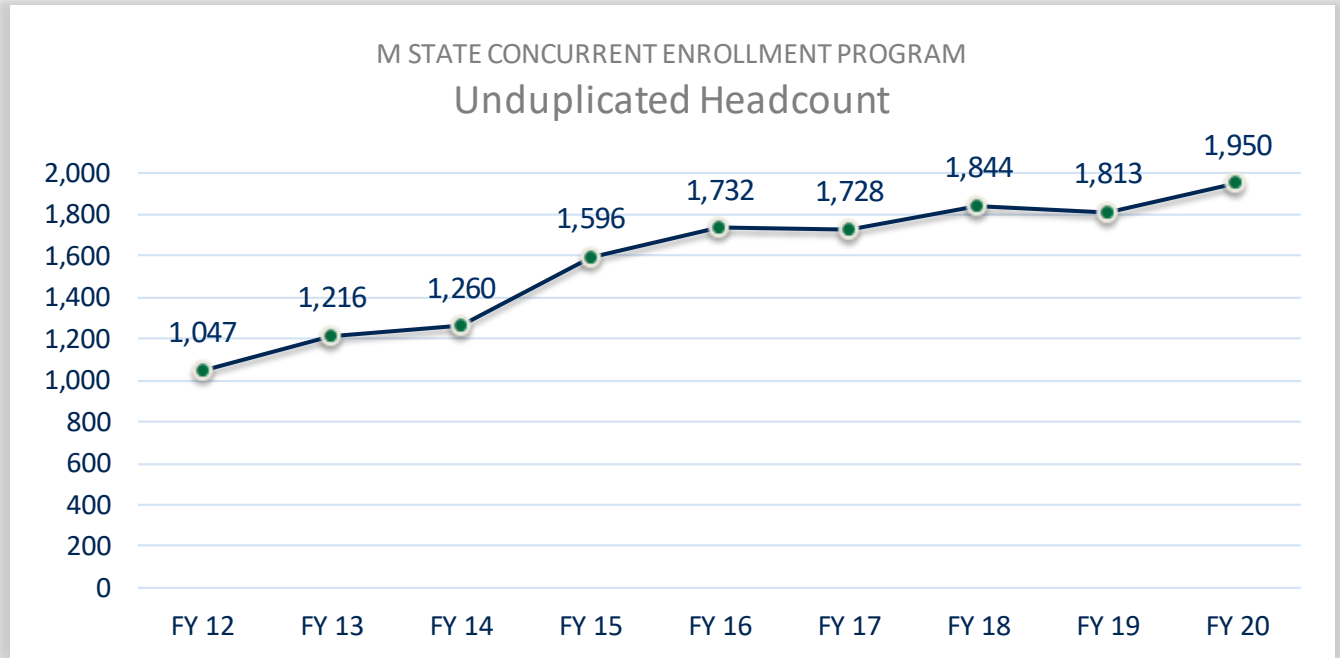
History of Quality Partnerships

M State’s Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP) has over 30 years of experience serving partner districts and is accredited by the [National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Partnerships \(NACEP\)](#). In FY20, M State is partnering with 43 districts in west central rural Minnesota to provide dual credit courses in the high school classroom, taught by qualified high school instructors who are mentored by M State faculty. The number of K12 partnerships has continued to grow over the years without compromising the quality or integrity of the program.

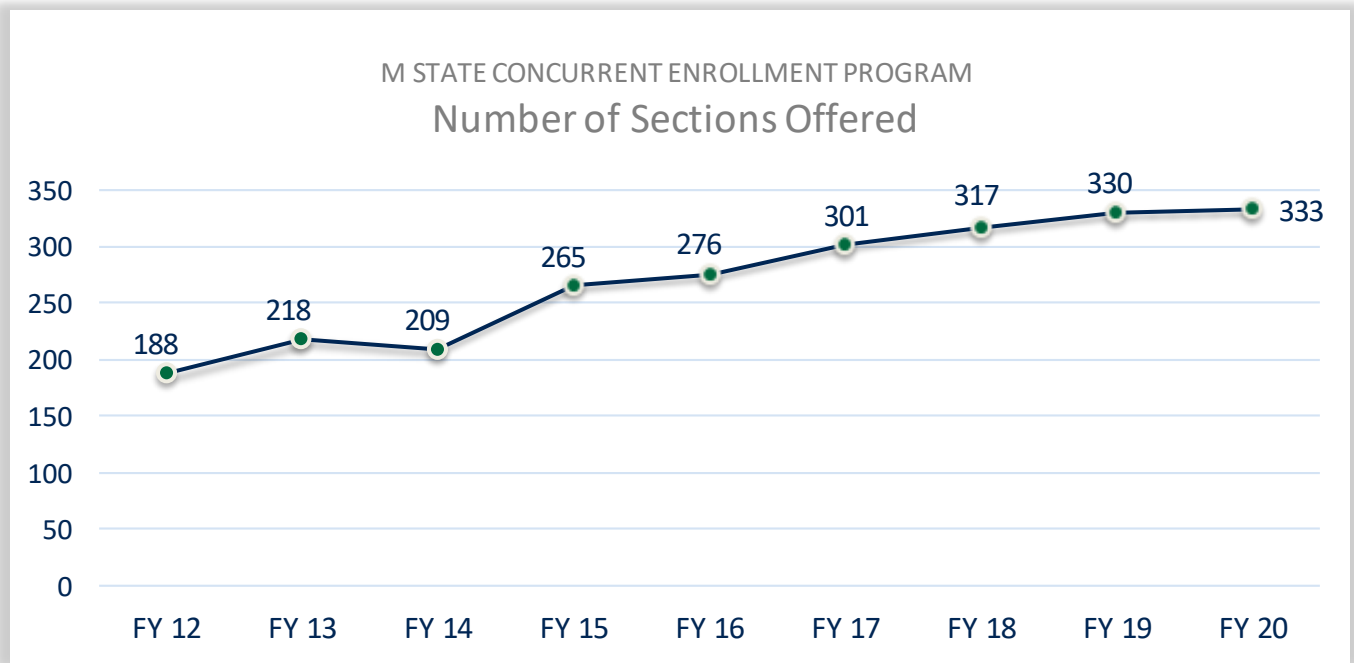


Consistent Growth

M State's CEP is serving over 1,900 students in FY20. The program has experienced a healthy 46.7 percent growth in enrollment since FY12.



In FY20, 135 concurrent instructors delivered/are delivering over 330 sections of concurrent credit courses, which is a 37 percent increase over the past six fiscal years.



The number of sections offered includes multiple sections of the same course and ITV courses.

Credits Awarded

Students earned over 16,000 credits FY20. Concurrent courses are delivered at no cost to the student in Minnesota. The college saved students and their families over \$2.7 million (based on M State’s tuition of \$165.50 per credit x 16,339 FY20 registered credits).
