





Fall to Fall Headcount


eCHS served over 160 students fall 2017. The program continues to experienced a healthy growth in enrollment.





Credits Awarded

The program awarded over 900 credits fall 2017, saving Minnesota high school students and their families over \$150,000 based on M State's in-state tuition rate of \$165.50 per credit.
