


History of Quality Partnerships

In FY19, M State is partnering with 15 districts in west central rural Minnesota to provide online dual credit courses in the high school classroom, taught by M State faculty. The number of K12 partnerships has continued to grow over the years without compromising the quality or integrity of the program.




Enrollment by Course

eCHS courses are chosen to meet various Minnesota Transfer Curriculum goal areas and offer an array of access to various general education and technical course credits.




Spring to Spring Headcount

eCHS served over 200 students spring 2019. The program continues to experienced a healthy growth in enrollment.



Credits Awarded

The program awarded close to 1,000 credits spring 2019, saving Minnesota high school students and their families over \$164,000 based on M State's in-state tuition rate of \$165.50 per credit.



Grade Distribution

Spring 2019, 87 percent of eCHS students successfully passed their course with a grade of C or better.
