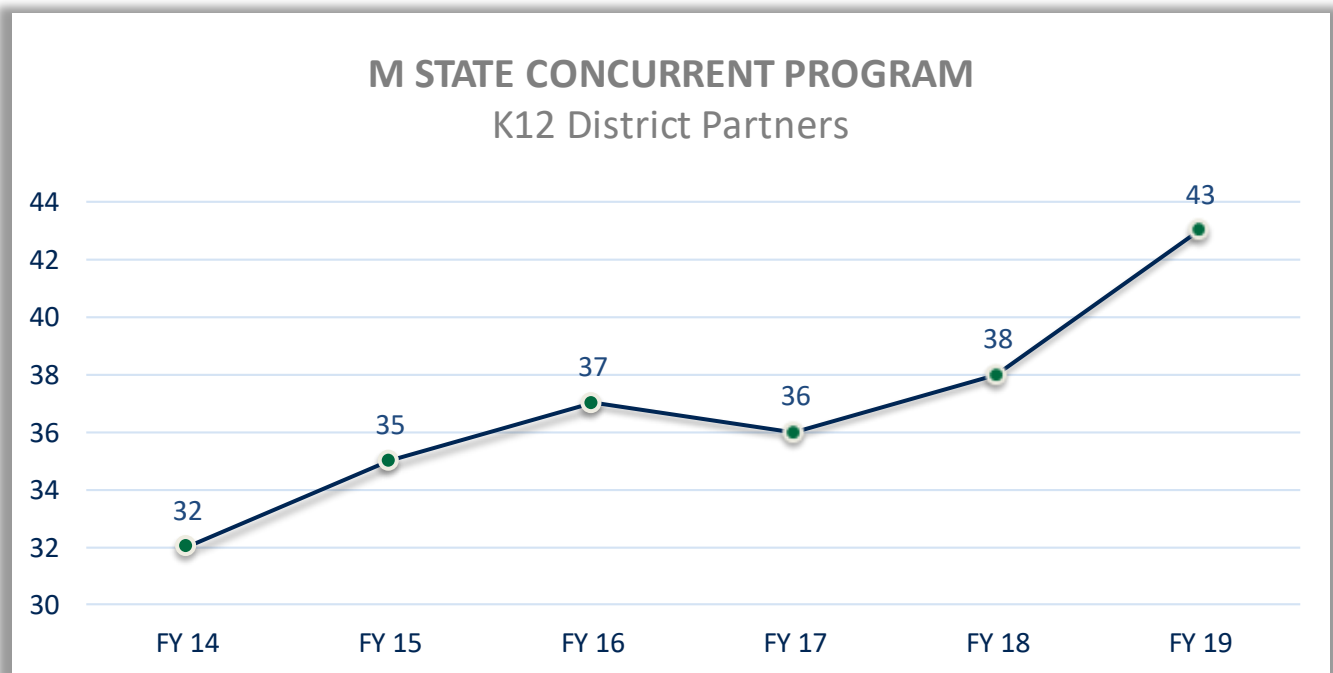

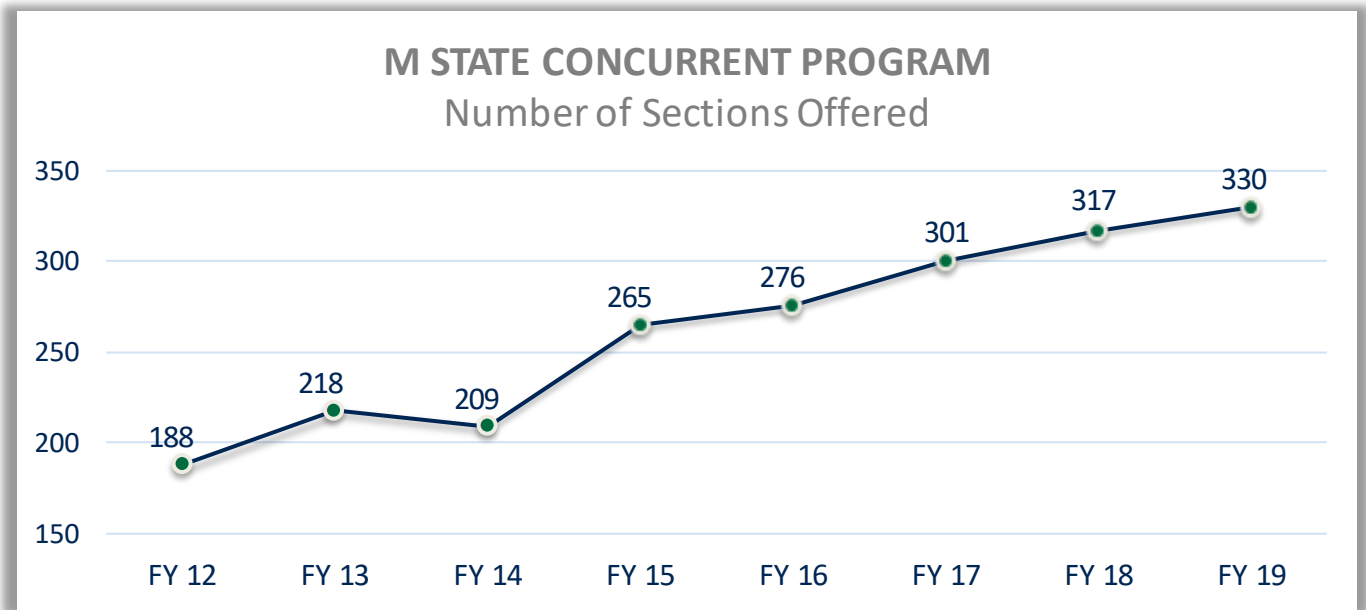
District Partnerships

M State's number of K12 partnerships continues to grow without compromising the quality and integrity of the program. In FY19, M State partnered with 43 districts in west central rural Minnesota to provide dual credit courses in the high school classroom.



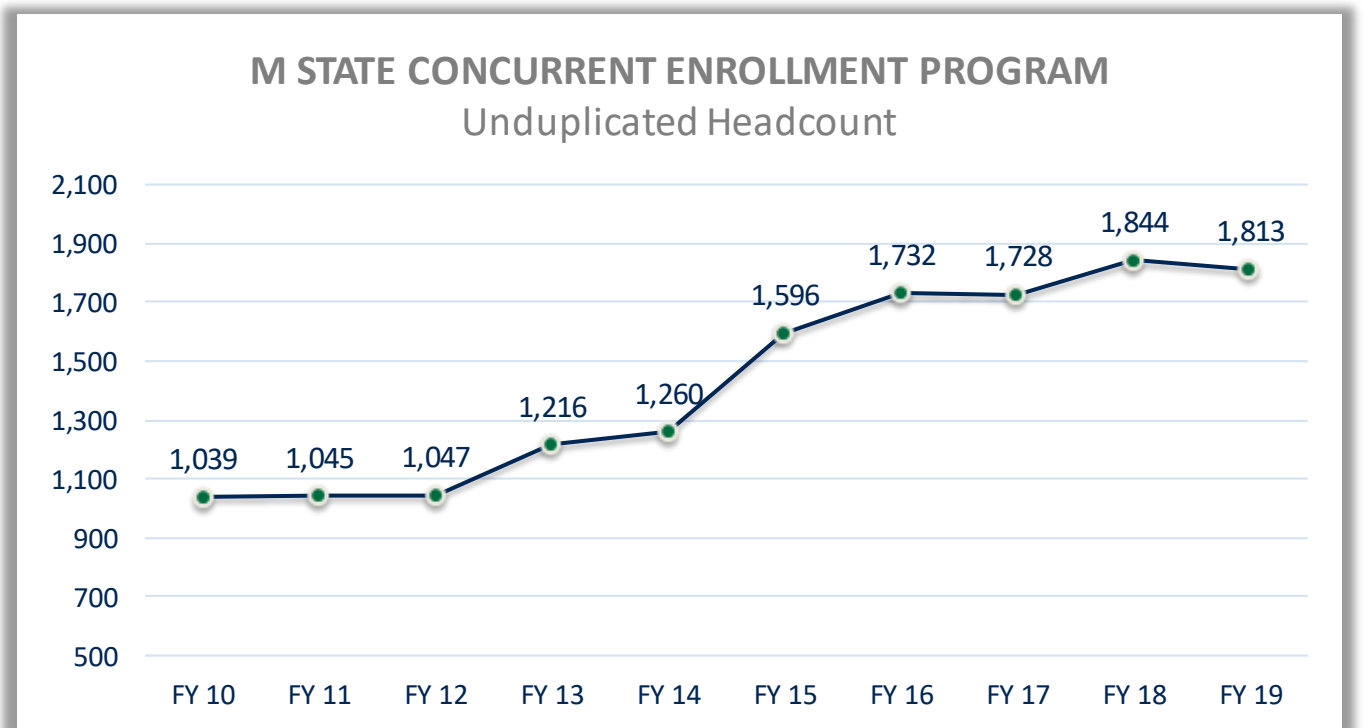
Total Number of Sections Offered

The number of sections offered includes multiple sections of the same course and ITV courses. In FY19, 123 concurrent instructors delivered 330 sections of concurrent credit courses, a 4 percent increase over FY18 and a 37 percent increase over the past five fiscal years.



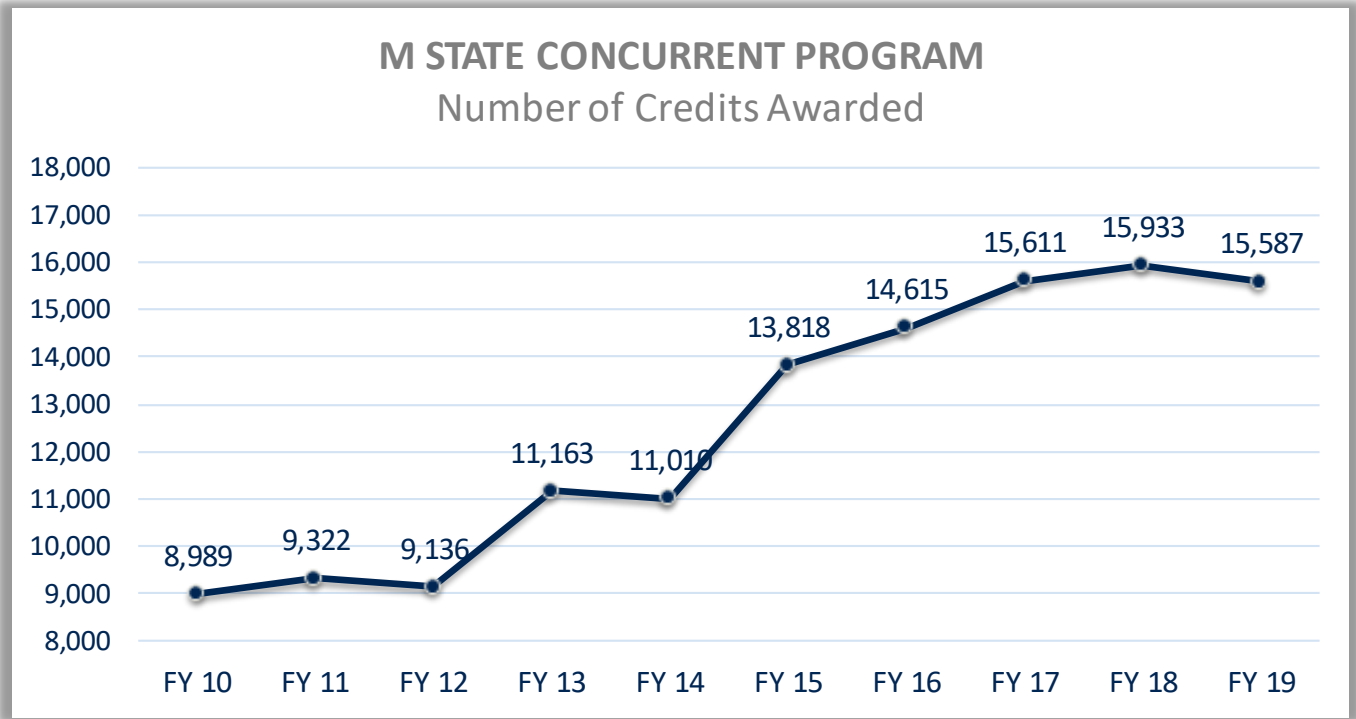
Unduplicated Headcount

The Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP) served over 1,800 students in FY19. The program has experienced a healthy growth in enrollment since FY12.



Credits Awarded

The program awarded 15,587 credits during the 2018-19 academic year, saving Minnesota high school students and their families over \$2.5 million.
