Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Skills Training

One-one-one instruction with an expert in the field. M State offers a 5-hour and a 15-hour course. Both courses include behind-the-wheel training. The focus of these courses is to prepare the student for CDL licensure. Courses include a combination of pre-trip and behind the wheel training. Preparation for testing and hands-on inspection of the truck are included.

Note: on February 7, 2022, new federal regulations for obtaining a CDL will go into effect and will be significantly more expensive and difficult to get. If you have your permit before this date, you will be grand-fathered in to the current regulations and have 6 months to test.

Requirements prior to training:

- 1. Complete this registration form and make full payment (Check or credit card)
- 2. Complete Vehicle Use Agreement (Have the ability to pass driving background check)
- 3. Supply a copy of a valid CDL permit (Good for 6 months, but has possibility of extension)
- 4. Supply a copy of a current DOT health card

After receiving CDL permit, you **MUST**:

- 1. Register in FMCSA Drug & Alcohol Clearinghouse using the student driver designation and indicating "Minnesota State Community and Technical College" as your C/TPA
- 2. Get a drug test (drug test must be within 30 days of start of training)
- 3. Provide a copy of drug test results

REGISTRATION IS NOT CONSIDERED COMPLETE AND TRAINING WILL NOT BEGIN UNTIL <u>ALL</u> REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET.
