#### Prerequisites:

- Completion of a Minnesota Department of Health-approved Nursing Assistant training program (Proof required at registration)
- Current Nursing Assistant registry status

#### North Dakota Medication Assistant II Certification

**Course Structure:** 48-hour classroom/lab instruction \*\*Additional 32-hour clinical component required for certification


#### Prerequisites:

- Current Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) registry status


#### Clinical Requirement:

- Students must be sponsored by their employing North Dakota facility to participate in the 32-hour clinical component
- Alternatively, students may complete the 48-hour classroom/lab training first and secure a sponsoring facility within **six months** to complete the clinical requirement.
